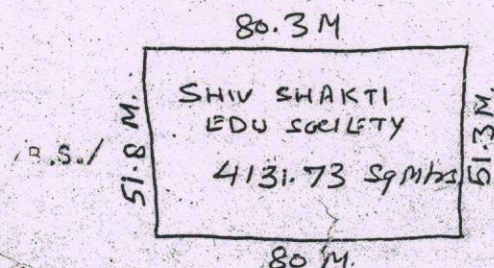



With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi for the recognition of your school for class Ist to 8th w.e.f. Academic Session 2004-2005 to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of DESA & R 1973 framed there under as well as the instructions issued from time to time by the department.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of Caste and Creed.
3. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for the students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per students shall be purchased and made available to the students.
4. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available for the students.
5. That the employees of the school will be given pay and allowances & other prescribed benefits as provided under section 10(1) of DESA & R 1973, and Rule 125 of DESA & R 1973.

7. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.

9. The Managing Committee of the school shall not increase fees in future academic session without prior approval of Director of Education which is a mandatory requirement under sub-section of section 17 of DSEA & R 1973.

11. That all the facilities prescribed under 50 & 51 of the DSEA & R 1973 shall be made available to the students.

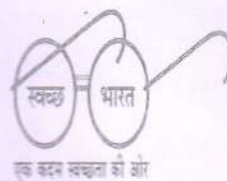
